- > Over 1 million orphaned children in the country
- > Life expectancy is 40 years
- > 12% of the population (1.72 million people) are infected with HIV/AIDS
- > 30% of all school aged children have lost at least one parent
- > Population of 14 250 000 in an area only twice the size of Nova Scotia



THE MINISTRY OF VOH MALAWI

The mission of the village of Hope is to bring lasting hope to children at risk so they can embrace adulthood as independent and contributing members of society. Children are provided with food and shelter, clothing, clean water, healthcare and education, but most importantly, they are given a family and the opportunity to know Jesus Christ personally. When a child comes to the VOH they are placed in a home with 7 to 9 other children, a house mother and an auntie (helper). Currently VOH Malawi has five homes that are occupied. An additional three houses have been built and the current goal is to operate 12 homes and care for 120 Children.
